

Preprint in engineering sciences

- Submitted version, pre-print or author's original = version which has not yet been **submitted to a journal**, or that **has not been peer reviewed**.



! In engineering sciences : no posting the *preprint* online before publication of the manuscript with the publisher

Risk

Posting the *preprint* online before being approved for publication

- If the manuscript is rejected, **submitting** it to another publisher or journal may be **compromised** due to self-plagiarism.
- If the *preprint* is **posted online** in an archive **before the published version is published**, the journal can reject the article

Advice

The Library's advice

- When you upload your manuscript, **do not agree to upload your *preprint* to publisher platforms** such as Research Square, SSRN, Authorea, etc
- For safe and fast dissemination, **prioritize depositing your author accepted manuscript in the open archive HAL**

Depositing your *preprint*, a disciplinary and open practice

Uploading *preprints* to open archives such as Arxiv, HAL, and Zenodo is **possible and valued in certain disciplines** (physics, mathematics, computer science, economics, biology...). **Some journals also allow it**, such as diamond journals
